Minimum requirement for the anesthesia position is one year of experience in administering anesthetics to humans and/or animals. Education in anesthesiology may be substituted for experience as determined relevant by the agency.

Necessary Special Requirements: Anesthesia technician position: Veterinary technicians current registration certificate plus specified experience upon employment Nurse anesthetists: current registration certificate upon employment.

**1. Identify a vacancy in which you are interested in applying**

**2. Register your personal data**

The State will mail you your applicant number. However, **you do not need to wait for your number to apply** complete this step and send your application. KSU Human Resources can look your number up for you.

**3. Complete the Employment Application**
