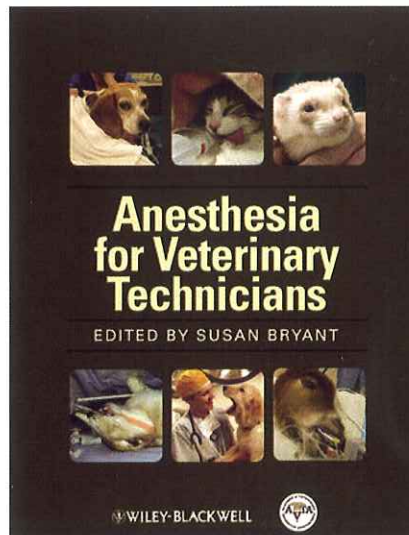

The book “is a highly practical guide to anesthesia skills” and is published “in association with the Academy of Veterinary Technician Anesthetists (AVTA).” This book provides concise information beginning with a review of cardiac and respiratory physiology and its relationship to anesthesia, through 35 additional chapters covering “preparation, equipment, anesthesia techniques, and pain assessment and manage-



ment. Techniques for a variety of species, including equine, small mammal and ruminant patients” are included.
